Daily Maintanance

- Sweep or blow off leaves, dust, and debris regularly to prevent surface abrasion.
- Rinse with a hose occasionally to remove built-up dirt or residues, especially in outdoor or high-traffic areas.
- Use protective pads under metal furniture or planters to prevent rust marks and scratches.

Sealing

- Porphyry is a dense and durable stone with low porosity, but sealing is still recommended to reduce staining and make cleaning easier.
- Apply a high-quality penetrating/impregnating sealer designed for dense natural stones and outdoor conditions.
- Perform initial sealing during or immediately after installation.
- Reapply sealer every 1–2 years depending on exposure to weather, cleaning frequency, and traffic levels.
- A color-enhancing sealer can be used to deepen the natural tones and bring out the stone's variation—always test on a small area first.

Cleanning

- Clean with a pH-neutral stone cleaner or a mild soap diluted in water.
- Do not use acidic cleaners (vinegar, lemon, harsh grout cleaners), which will etch and damage the surface.
- Low-pressure washing is safe.
- For algae, mold, or mildew, use a stone-safe outdoor biocide or mildew remover—avoid chlorine bleach.
- For stubborn stains, use a poultice specific to the stain type (oil, rust, etc.). Re-seal after treating stains.
